The DE in Indigenous Language and Revitalization aims to create an interdisciplinary course of study and draw together an intellectual cohort that will equip graduate students from various departments with knowledge of the methods, histories, and goals of indigenous language revitalization and reclamation.

1. Short statement (500 words) about your background and reasons for applying to the DE. Describe how you see the DE fitting into your short-term and long-term academic and research goals.
2. Short letter from your faculty advisor in support of your participation in the DE.
3. Unofficial transcript downloaded from CalCentral.
4. Current CV
